Cascade Clamps - Established in Portland, Oregon in 1943, the Cascade Manufacturing Company started as a small machine store hiring just four people. Overall sales for that year totaled \$60,000. The very first recorded sales revenues involved the assembly and machining of stainless-steel pipe fittings, valves and different parts. Through 5 years of operation, the business had stretched to forty employees and their annual sales volume had increased to three hundred thirty thousand dollars. Today, Cascade is amongst the top international producers within the material handling industry.

Production and design of the company's original hydraulic cylinder paved the way in Cascade's aggressive pursuit of new business possibilities. Over the last sixty years, the material handling trade has developed into a highly complex area and Cascade has proudly performed a part in this growth. Cascade presently continues to develop as the premier provider of forklift accessories and different related items. The company feels assured in their capability to continue to lead the way within the business by understanding customer's requirements in the future and remaining aggressive in the international market.

All through the 1950's, Cascade began to manufacture, design, and sell its hydraulic attachments. A brand new facility was made in the year 1956, so as to house all the plant operations and offices in Portland, Oregon, which is still the company's present center of operations. After 15 years of business, total employees reached 180 employees and sales had reached almost two million three hundred thousand dollars.

A second manufacturing plant was built in 1959 in Springfield, Ohio. nineteen sixty marked Cascade's initial move into the global world of the material handling industry while the company recognized interest in the Netherlands, England, and Australia.

The business changed its name to Cascade Corporation in the year 1964. In 1965, Cascade went public with a preliminary offering of two hundred thousand shares of common stock. The business has expanded its manufacturing plants throughout the United States with places in Warner Robins, Georgia, Portland, Oregon and Springfield, Ohio. Cascade products are manufactured worldwide thanks to numerous subsidiary operations. In 1994, a new facility was accomplished in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European head office. This facility is made to be the essential customer support centre.

Continuing to grow, Cascade expanded their product offering further in 1996 and 1997 with the impressive acquisition of 5 companies, including the global best in blades, the Kenhar Corporation.
