To correctly and meticulously rebuild a forklift engine, a good company would totally disassemble it. A heat cleaning system could then be used to clean all the components. As soon as this step has been finished, all of the components are checked to see if they have any extensive wear, any defects or breakage. Some components such as cylinder blocks, connecting blocks, cylinder heads and crankshafts are reground, resurfaced and resized if considered necessary. Several components like bolts, gears, nuts and all that, are repaired or replaced as needed.

The engine is rebuilt by hand once the overhaul has been accomplished. After putting it back together, a series of tests are applied to the running machine. This is done to be able to check all of the components to ensure there are no issues or leaks. If any problems occur, the necessary changes are done.
