

## Side Tilt Carriage

Side Tilt Carriage - Rated by the tine carriage hoisting capacity, there are actually four sizings of hook type tine carriages. The hook type fork carriages have been standardized.

The carriage bar spacing utilized for Class 1 is more or less 13 inches and the Class 1 carriage is rated to carry cargo as much as 2000lbs. The Class 2 carriage is rated to carry loads up to 5,500lbs with carriage bar spacing of 16 inches. Class III carriages are rated for cargo as much as 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this particular class is twenty inches. Class IV carriages are rated for cargo as much as 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing used for this capacity is 25 inches.

The carriages for pin type tines can be different depending on the maker. Pin mounted blades may vary by the amount of offset between the tine eye and the blade. Carriage capacity will be determined by the carriage pin size and by the fork size.
